Dr. S. G. Mahajan : A Well-Known Indian Library Professional

Dr. S.G.Mahajan

Dr Shantaram Gajan Mahajan (born 9th October 1932 at Junnar near Pune), is a versatile senior most personality in the field of Library and Information Science at the Indian National level. His versatile personality is defined basically by his worthy contribution of LIS

professorship and a stupendous science, a hard-core teacher of knowledge organization and academic librarianship and a dynamic University Librarian, Jaykar Library SavitribaiPhule Pune University, Pune, Maharashtra India

His contribution is more than 71 years in this profession and still in the advisory role to youngsters. He is student of DRTC Bangalore, and also a disciple of Dr S R Ranganathan, father of Indian Library Science. He worked as Librarian, Professor and Head Department of LIS in prestigious well known university SavitribaiPhule Pune University (formerly Pune University), Jayakar Library. He is a great visionary and in 1990 he initiated ICT in LIS and using LIBSYS he started automation of libraries and conducted CDS/ISIS courses. He established a computer lab in the Library School at Jayakar Library. He also established Pu La Deshpande Microfilming Unit in Jayakar Library. He initiated conservation and preservation of manuscripts

program in the library to preserve valuable manuscript collection. He always transformed himself and adopted the new technologies and amended in the library during his tenure 1954-1992. He is honoured by "Lifetime Achievement Award" by IASLIC. The glimpses of the achievements are very difficult to express in words for such an all-round dedicated personality. After retirement he wrote 53 books and still busy in writing for another books.

Education:

He completed his secondary education from a very famous educational institutes, Nutan Marathi Vidhyalay (Popularly known as (numavi), NMV) Pune, graduated from S P College, Pune and did Postgraduation from Pune University (now SPPU). He is highly qualified and acquired qualifications MA, PhD, M LIB I Sc. from DRTC, Bangalore in first Rank. He is a student of Dr S R Ranganathan and gained expertise in colon classification and cataloguing. The doctorate was awarded for him for his research "History of the Public Library Movement in Western Maharashtra 1805 – 1921". BA from Pune University (1957), Diploma in Librarianship (1959), MA (1972), Associateship in Documentation (MLIB)DRTC Bangalore (now M S in LIS) (1978-1979), Ph.D. (1979).

Noble Library and Information Professional:

He has a profound experience in the fieldof LIS and he worked in different positions from 1949 to 1992. He headed department of LIS as Professor and Librarian of Pune University (Now SPPU) from 1954-1992. Prior to this he was associated with Kesari-Maratha Library 1949-1954. He retired from the Pune University in 1992. After his retirement he established Pune Library Network 1992-1994.

LIS Education

During his tenure he was associated with YCMOU Nasik and he worked as an editor for the 34 course materials for LIS students (B Lib). The UGC major research projects completed by him are Bibliography of Pune City (Pune city Bibliography) and Encyclopaedia of Pune city (Pune shaharachaDynankosh) in Marathi which are very popular since based on local history of Pune city.

A Dedicated Professional

More than seven decades active in the profession, out of this four decades in the profession and nearing to three decades actively participating as an advisory senior most professionals to young professionals who visit to him for consultation. He is still busy in writing professional literature, recreational literature, historical literature and share views with others.

An Ideal and Hard-Core Teacher

He is a hard core teacher, started his teaching carrier in 1951 to certificate course. He is totally devoted person to LIS and always taking care of profession, for the first time he has started evening B Lib I Sc. and two vearsvocational batch for the M Lib I Sc. in Pune University for the working library professionals, many professionals were benefited due to this facility. He has also conducted number of courses on "Library Automation" as a co-ordinator and these were funded by different government agencies. He delivered spontaneous lectures to LIS students in all subjects but cataloguing, classification (His suggestions were even accepted by Dr Ranganathan and incorporated in the Classified Catalogue Code), documentation, library movement in India, public library system, academic Library system are the most popular among them. Mrs Dr Neeta Patil also completed her research study on the life work of Dr S G Mahajan and her topic of research was "Dr. S G Mahajan yanche granthalay ani mahiti shastra sahityatil yogdan" in 2015, and also published in book from later by student. He was a Ph.D. Guide to research scholars.

A Perfect Administrator and Organiser

He is very prompt, disciplined and systematic in his work. He is the best leader and manager and deployprofessional tasks to proper person. He has routine procedures and daily he takes round in the complete library premises and solve the issues of staff working with him. He developed Degree and Post Graduate courses in Library and Information Science in

Pune University, also started evening and vocational courses for BLIB and MLIB. First to develop computer and internet lab in LIS school at national level t Pune University. Organised seminars, conferences, special training courses, workshops etc., in collaboration of different professional organisations, associations like IATLIS, "Maharashtra RajyaGranthalaySangh", PULISAA etc.

A Prolific Writer

He is a prolific writer and contributed almost more than 89 books (form English and Marathi Languages) on different areas including LIS. He wrote 21 books for certificate course, 10 books for B Lib I Sc and 3 books for M L I Sc. The bibliography of his publications is presented at the end. Dr A P J Kalam himself appreciated Dr Mahajan for the book written by him on his biography "Rameshwaram to Rashtrapati Bhayan".

- An excellent Planner and forecaster

Initially he started his writing form 1951 and published his contributions in "Kesari" and "SahityaSahakar" and till date he is busy in writing professional experiences which act as a guiding pole to younger generation.

Foreign Educational Visits:

He was awarded prestigious fellowship from British Library UK, British Council (1988) to visit England and Wells to study local history and review library profession and implement concepts in India. He presented his study on Local history at Paris International conference focusing on Pune city historical tools.

Research Contribution

He has guided many research students in Library Science and as an external referee also conducted viva for the Ph. D. students from the different universities of India. He has also guided M Lib and MPhil students for their research projects.

Research Projects:

He has initiated many research projects and sanctioned different projects from UGC, DST, NISSAT, CSIR, INFLIBNET and completed research projects by appointing fresh library science students as project assistants, these project assistants received early professional experience and now few of them are

heading in different organisations as librarians.

Committees and Commissions

During his tenure he worked on many committees and commissions in different capacities from chairperson and secretary, few notables are: UGC committee, DST committees, INFLIBNET, NISSAT, INSDOC (Now NISCAIR), CSIR, PUNENET, All India Librarians Associations etc. During his tenure he also organised national and international level conferences in Pune University Jayakar Library. He was member of notable UGC-CDC Syllabus Revision Committee. Member of Library Science Dictionary (Paribhasha Cosh) appointed by Maharashtra State Govt. (Maharashtra State Council). Nominated by VC as an expert for selection of Professor. He was Member of Senate, Pune University, Academic Council Member of PU, Chairman and member of Board of Studies of different universities. Active participation in Indian Library movement at different levels. Worked as Secretary of Maharashtra Library Association.

He has compiled a bibliography and encyclopaedia of city and published 2 books on Pune city. He was author of biography of Dr APJ Abdul Kalam entitled "Rameshwaram to RashtrapatiBhavan". He established in Pune Univerity "Pune City History

Dalan". Organised All India Local History Conference and written books on Local history of Pune City.

He retired in 1992, but still very active in Profession. He is enjoying his life with his family members and also guides to youngsters in the profession. Still spending half, a day in reading and compiling data and intellectual writing. He spends some time in recreation also. He is presently residing in his bungalow "SaraswatiVihar" at 27, Swatishri Society, Ganesh Nagar, Behind COSMOS Bank, Near Alankar Police station, Pune 411052. Residence 020-25465206. He is available to everyone and spend time with visitors happily.

Publications

125 research articles are on his credit, which were published and presented in national and International conferences and workshops. 89 Books. Guided 6 PhD

and 4 M Phil Research scholars.

He Published his books on various areas including LIS viz. Maharashtra State Library Association (7), Pune VidhyathriGruha Pune (15), English Books (11), On The city of Pune (8), for YCMOU (7),MLIS (2), IGNOU (3), Research Guidance (6)Publications from Pune University Jayakar Library (13), Other publications (17). At present he is writing on "Habits of successful Librarians" (List of 83 Publications is Appended at the end)

Message to young Library Professionals

His views are totally different, whatever he has earned in terms of knowledge, as an experienced professional, hewants to return to society by way of sharing his ideas in writing. He advised the professionals to:

- Compile reference books useful to profession and society like compilation of bibliographies, biography of eminent personalities in localities,
- Preparation of subject dictionaries (ParibhashaKosh)
- Directories of professionals and experts with their biodata
- Compilation of charitrakosha in Marathi
- Prepare directories of librarians, booksellers, publishers,
- Compile who's who of librarians, medical professionals useful to society in general

Publish books which are useful to society and profession.

His Plan of PUNENET for resource sharing was accepted by NISSAT (DSIR) Delhi and worked as its first Director from 1992-1994. He participated as member of committee on different organisations and put forth his plans and vision to UGC, INFLIBNET, DSIR, ICSSR, IGNOU, YCLMOU and UGC-CDC.

Very rare to find such a down to earth professional who served library profession efficiently and his contribution I valuable as a guiding pole to new entrants.
