Homage to Dr.S. R. Ranganathan, Father of Library Science in India on his 128th Birth Anniversary (1892-2020): Remembering his contributions on account of Librarians Day

August 12th is celebrated as National Librarian's Day in India, in remembrance of national professor of Library Science, and father of Library science Dr S R Ranganathan (1892-1972), who had a leading role in Library and library profession development in India. His contribution was acknowledged by interactional library professionals and respected him all over the world. His most notable contributions to the field were his five laws of library science and the development of the first major faceted classification system, the colon classification. A notable Indian librarian and educator who was considered the father of library science in India and whose contributions had worldwide influence. Though a mathematician, he took training in LIS and his contributions are recognized throughout the world. No area left untouched by him in the LIS profession.

Development of 'ENTRY' software at AV Arts, KM Commerce, ESA Science College, Vasai Road (West), Dist. Palghar: An experiment

Development of New Concept

The software used at AV Arts, KM Commerce, ESA Science College library do not have some facilities / utilities, which needed by library staff to fulfill their requirements. Initially library was maintaining user entry registers in different sections like Property counter, Internet lab, Reference section, Reading and Discussion Sections of library and maintained visitor records. The users visiting the library had to enter their names in the registers kept in different sections and then avail the services. Recently library installed a PC at the property counter for the login/logout of user Entry/Exit and registration software. Users are now not supposed to enter in register but system takes care of visitor entry.

New Concept Initiation

One-day library staff Mr Paresh Kharpade approached me, with his developed concept of using one excel sheet and entry of students in excel. He collected students and books data and used lookup command for making the entries.

Although it was working, there was issue of creating manual entries every-time. He changed some data type also. Looking at his efforts, and after studying the concept, I decided to take it further and use his conceptual idea and developed an application for entry/exit record.

I collected the same data from him and then further used excel and VBA to develop a proper application for the same. Though, I started it for entry/exit, some suggestions also received from my library staff that they also use register to maintain the records of Newspapers, Journals and Reference books issue/return. If something can be done in that direction might be helpful and attain ease in their manual work.

I initiated working on this issue and developed a software and named it "Entry Software". Now this "entry software" is used at different sections like internet, periodicals, newspaper, reference and discussion section for keeping entry/exit records of students and also issuing them periodicals, newspapers, reference books in the library premises. Now, it is a complete software for a small library. As it can maintain books record, students' record, visit and issue return records. At present there are 7000 students in our premises and successfully handling entry data in library sections through this software. Our library staff found it very useful as it was time saving for students as well as them also. At present this "Entry software" is in testing mode at our library and received satisfactory remarks from staff and users. We have shared this concept to just develop awareness among the library professionals.

New Technology in Library

Sanitization to Combat Covid-19

Although Covid-19 has changed virtual library into virtual reality, still libraries will always be in vogue to use as a place for study, reading and document access. When the spread of covid-19 is still persistent, academic librarians are expected to be committed to the safety and well being of its users. Libraries can use Automatic Hand Sanitizer Dispenser which can be easily placed on a wall. These works well with electricity and battery. They nebulize hand sanitizer or disinfectant liquid without any touch. They are equally beneficial in elimination of any chance of cross contamination and contribute to the optimal hand hygiene. There are also some touchless sanitizer dispensers such as by Zero-B which has been developed on WHO guidelines. The size can be from 2 liter to 50 liter. It can be placed at any place of the library. It is equally effective in sanitizing door and cupboard handles, stair railings, lifts and escalators. The North-east Document Conservation Center (NEDCC) recommends a 24 to 48-hour quarantine of returned books as the safest and most effective way to disinfect them. The studies currently indicated that COVID-19 may last on surfaces such as cardboard for 24 hours. (<https://www.medrxiv.org/content/10.1101/2020.03.09.20033217v1.full.pdf>). To resolve this issue, library book sanitizer are also in the market costing up to Rs \$4300.00 per item. This machine is useful in that it kills pathogenic bacteria like Covid-19. It sanitizes 6 books at a time within 30 seconds. ([pikinc.biz/product/library-book-sanitizer/](http://www.pikinc.biz/product/library-book-sanitizer/)) Some book shower machines are also in the market to sterilize not only the outer part of books but inner parts and cover of books also. It uses ultraviolet rays and natural aroma to make the showering pleasant.

Besides this, regular hand sanitizers need to be placed at the entrance, reception desk, stacks, reading rooms and at the circulation desk. Washroom should be cleaned several times. The floors, desks, chair call for cleaning frequently. Big sized libraries might hire the professional services in this respect.

RFID enabled self check-in and check out center could serve as a greater comfort to avoid direct human contact. Book drop stations at the important places in the campus would be helpful in continuation traditional library services after post covid-19 situation. This can be effective in terms of efficiency, convenience and adherence to technology. However, implementation of such technology must be envisaged in the environment of ongoing pandemic. Librarians should also be cautious to confirm whether the disinfectant liquid i.e. Lysol or bleach or any other disinfectant material can demolish virus. Ultraviolet light may also be proving as risk factor as it can damage the library material.

Even though above mentioned technology offers optimistic view to wrestle against covid-19, yet it would be on its economic feasibility to reap the benefits of such upcoming technology. Nevertheless, libraries are not expected to be at back while resorting to technology in the current scenario.

We must wait for more sincere and authenticated research to take any decision over this. However, academic libraries

must not hesitate to make use of common cleaning practices. The security of the users must be prioritized before all.

MUCLA Event Report

Third MUCLA National Conference on “Reinventing Academic Libraries for New Education System in Digital Age : Challenges and Opportunities”

Maharashtra University and College Librarians Association organized its third National Conference in association with Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Sectional Council, Aurangabad of Maharashtra University and College Librarians Association on Feb 7-8, 2020.

The conference is inaugurated by Hon Shri Vikramji Kale, MLA (Marathwada Teachers Constituency, Aurangabad). On this occasion Dr Mohan Kherde, President of MUCLA; Dr S K Patil, Conference Director; Dr Dharmaraj Veer, Coordinator Dr BAMU Aurangabad Sector Council; Dr Daya Patil (Dalve), Organizing Secretary; Dr Veena M Kamble, Convener and Dr Shivshankar Ghumare was on the dais.

During inaugural function, Dr. Dharmaraj Veer highlighted the issues faced by library professionals in colleges as well as universities in Maharashtra. Dr. Mohan Kherde expressed the view that the government should think positively to solve the problems of Librarians and requested

MLA to look into matter considering the benefits of library professionals. Dr S K Patil, as Director of the Conference highlighted the importance of the conference and briefly elaborated the selection of theme and sub themes. Chief Guest Hon' ble Shri Vikramji Kale presented his views on the different issues related to library professionals and agreed to look into this matter positively and purse the matter with the education ministry. Dr Kherde presented an appeal on behalf of all MUCLA Members to MLA and he accepted it and agreed to conduct a meeting with ministry at early time. Dr Daya Dalvi explained the organization of this conference at Aurangabad. Dr Veena Kamble, as a convener presented vote of thanks.

In the first technical session, the invited speaker Mr. Santosh Chaturbhuj highlighted future role of libraries, challenges and problems faced by library profession and suggested a few measures to overcome the problems. Dr. Madhukar Gharad chaired the session and Dr. Hariprasad Bidwe worked as session rapporteur.

The second session was on 'Digital Libraries and Social Media use in Library Services'. As a Invited Speaker Dr. N B Dahibhate highlighted the challenges in library services, problems faced by academic librarians in ICT era. He also focused on new dimensions of library services presented through digital libraries, using social media, ICT, development of library products and services for the sustenance of future, types of social media and useful sites for library and KRC, library services using SM and best practices. Dr Sanjay Desale chaired the session and Dr. Ganesh Kulkarni was the rapporteur

Being a invited speaker Mr Kishore Ingale compared the activities in the past and activities carried out in the present day technology era. He also highlighted the future of the libraries and how smartly librarians have to work. He also cited some examples in the real process carried out in corporate sector libraries. In this session delegates presented their papers. At the end of the session the formal vote of thanks was proposed by Chairperson Dr Subhash Chavan. Dr. Raju Tupe was the session rapporteur.

In the next morning in the fourth session the invited speaker Dr. Ranjit Dharmapurikar narrated the working of Institutional repositories, its administration, management, issues and challenges in detail. Speaker also highlighted benefit of consortia and development of IR. In this session 17 papers were presented on the themes IR with reference to Agriculture ETD, E-Content Management, E-Resource Management, Library Consortia, Marketing of Library

Services, Cloud computing and libraries, Development of Lib Websites, Intro to Online DB etc. The session ended with a lively discussion in which a number of delegates participated and raised issues pertaining to the content of the presented papers. At the end of the session the formal vote of thanks was proposed by Chairperson Dr Pradeep Rai. Dr. Govardhan Aute worked as rapporteur of the session.

After the fourth session as usual the felicitation program of retired librarians from BAMU Aurangabad was organized. MUCLA organizes such activity in every annual conferences. Dr. Mohan Kherde was complimented the organizers for organizing such a successful convention and bringing together so many diverse stream and discuss some issues at a single platform. He hoped that participants will go back to their work places much wiser and keep the memories of this two days. Webinar-cum Lecture Series Jointly Organized by Indian Library Association (ILA) and Maharashtra University and College Library Association (MUCLA)

Indian Library Association (ILA) in association with Maharashtra University and College Library Association (MUCLA) conducted webinar-cum-lecture on 'Future Libraries' delivered by Prof. (Dr) Rajan Welukar, Former Vice Chancellor, Mumbai. The event took place on 12th May, 2020 on Zoom platform which was attended by more than 500 library professionals.

At the very outset, Dr. Priya Rai, the convener of ILA webinar series welcomed all the panelists including chief guest Dr. Rajan Welukar and briefed about the background behind organising this webinar. She told that scheduled webinar intended to update the knowledge and offer learning during Covid-19. She also informed about the earlier two webinar-cum lecture conducted by ILA.

Then Dr. Pradeep Rai, co-ordinator and Sr. Vice President of ILA gave information about ILA and its establishments, structure, functioning, association and activities.

Following this, Dr. Mohan R. Kherde being the President of MUCLA talked about the role played by it in conducting professional activities in Maharashtra and its association with ILA. 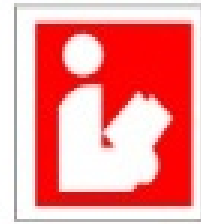

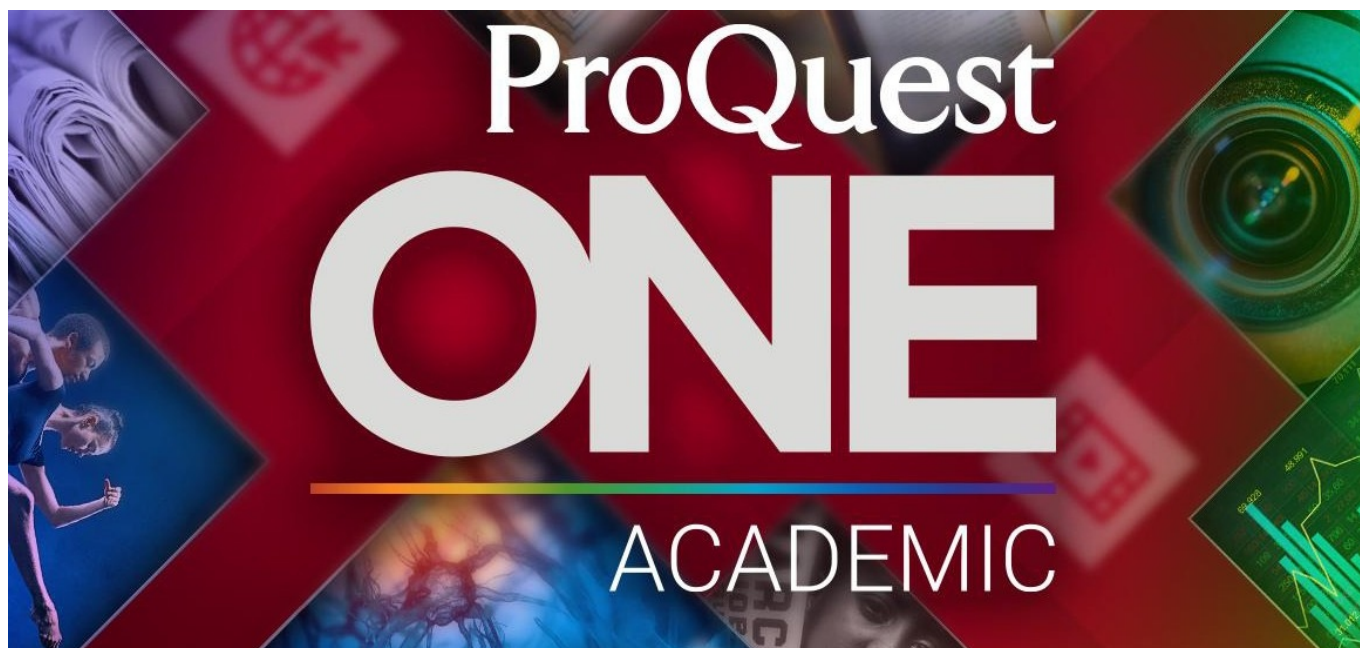
